ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT MOUNTAIN

Redemptive Purpose:

To reveal truth and beauty, and to advance the Kingdom of God through creative expression.

Primary Stronghold:

Idolatry - Exaltation of man or creation

FILM PROJECTS

Pray for locally related film projects to release light into darkness and advance the Kingdom. At least 2 film projects are being released that are notable: the first is “From Liberty to Captivity” a film that exposes human trafficking (by a Philly area filmmaker). The other is “Gosnell: The Trial of America’s Biggest Serial Killer” which focuses on the abortion clinic that was shut down in Philadelphia several years ago.

- Pray that these films would release light into the darkness, exposing chaos and calling it to order.
- Pray that Philadelphia would continue to be a birth place to quality films and documentaries that will be agents of kingdom advancement in our culture.
- Pray for protection for the film makers and their families as they boldly speak the truth about difficult and sensitive subject matter that some people may not want exposed.

LOCAL INITIATIVES

Pray that local art installations and initiatives would give glory to God. Art installations and initiatives are happening all over the city. From the art museum, to the airport, to coffeeshops and street corners, art is happening everywhere. Some is glorifying to God, and some is not. We are the gate keepers of our city, which means we decide what stays and what goes.

- Pray for locally founded artists and initiatives to prosper and reach many for the Kingdom. Some of these include: Voices In Power, Creatives, Christian Artists Guild, and many others.
- Pray that the influence of Satanic Black Masses being held at the Art Museum would be cancelled and not impact our city.



BUSINESS MOUNTAIN

Redemptive Purpose:

Wealth to establish God's covenant

Primary Stronghold:

Greed, mammon, poverty.

PERMANENT CLOSURE OF ILLICIT MASSAGE PARLORS

Pray illicit massage parlors and any other business that offers sex for sale are uncovered and shut down permanently.

Out of the estimated 9,000 illicit massage parlors known to be involved in human trafficking almost 1/10th are located in our area, according to a high profile non-profit agency that tracks human traffickers in the US. Chinatown and Rittenhouse areas are especially known as areas where these parlors keep springing up.

- Pray for the parlors and shell companies to be shut down permanently and for owners to lose their operating licenses.
- Pray for wisdom and strategy for our local government and law enforcement to find ways to work with legitimate business owners to interrupt, infiltrate and bring to justice all who are responsible for the trafficking through corrupt businesses.
- Pray for code regulators and police to work together and share information that will help bring down illegal operations.
- Pray for traffickers to come to a saving knowledge of Christ Jesus.

PRAY FOR THE PORNOGRAPHY INDUSTRY THAT FUELS HUMAN TRAFFICKING.

Pray all facets of the porn industry are exposed, profitability is eliminated and all involved encounter Jesus.

Philadelphia is home to over 30 adult film companies, 40 adult stores, and over 40 strip clubs. Philadelphia is known as a hub for porn production and distribution. The higher the public demand for porn in our area, the more likely sex traffickers will want to profit from the demand and exploit its victims. Many sites use victims of sex trafficking in adult films that are sold or made available via the Internet. Some are 12 years old and younger. Over 70% of victims are listed online with sites such as Craigslist and Back-page.

- Pray for the freedom, help and healing for all those who have been exploited, those that are exploiting, and for those that are responsible for the increasing demand (those who watch, go to the clubs, and finance the companies and stores).
- Pray for other cities and states to do as Arkansas, which recently recognized pornography as a public health crisis.
- Pray for the TV networks, businesses, and organizations that continue to normalize the exploitation of women.

EDUCATION FOR SMALL AND MINORITY OWNED BUSINESS OWNERS

Pray small and minority business owners are equipped to take advantage of business growth opportunities. According to PIDC, Philadelphia's public-private economic development corporation, minority businesses in the city need to fine-tune their operating budgets and improve their credit so they can access more lending options. To do this, they need more training and networking so they are prepared to fill the increasing number of vacancies left as Baby Boomer small business owners retire.

- Pray owners have vision for business development that will benefit them, their customers and the community.
- Pray that owners are connected with and use the growing number of business support services in the region to gain knowledge and networking necessary to grow their businesses.
- Pray opportunities and favor for owners to build their businesses and achieve the purposes God has for them and their business.

EDUCATION MOUNTAIN

Redemptive Purpose:

To teach the truth of God and His Word

Primary Stronghold:

Satan - the father of lies (John 8:44), pride, secular humanism

PROFANE AGENDAS

Pray anti-Christ agendas to indoctrinate students are revealed and canceled. These agendas come in many forms and all aim to pervert the image of God, so we no longer represent the temple of the Holy Spirit. This is the spirit behind the LGBTQ movement that seeks to indoctrinate children at early ages. As a 2011 article in *The Queerity*, a top online LGBT magazine proclaimed, "Can We Please Just Start Admitting that We DO Actually Want to Indoctrinate Kids?" Some local school districts are providing training for staff on how to present the lifestyle as normal.

- Pray protection for all children and youth no matter the life style they embrace or come from.
- Pray all who are caught up in alternative life styles, as well as school staff and students come to know the God who is Love through His son Jesus and find their deliverance and identity in Him alone.
- Pray eyes are opened to the deception of the enemy and hearts and minds protected from it.
- Pray for unbiased education to be conducted in our schools: politically, socially and economically.
- Pray for wisdom for believing teachers and students to work within the system to promote Godly values within education.

Scriptures: Isaiah 11:2, Proverbs 9:10, Proverbs 4, Psalm 119:66, 1 Peter 2: 1, Colossians 2:8

SCHOOL AND STUDENT SAFETY

Pray the regional school districts increase strategic safety measures regarding school violence, bullying and child vulnerability to human traffickers. National Center for Education Statistics and the Bureau of Justice reports that students feel safer than in recent years; however, a 12/17 article warns about increased crime. The Inquirer reported nearly 150 assaults on administrators and teachers in 2017-18; and an NBC story reported trafficking young children is such a problem in Philadelphia that the FBI added a second task force to handle its local caseload.

- Pray God inspired strategies to increase the preparedness and safety of school personnel, parents and students to deal with school violence, bullying and human trafficking, including safety, character development and emotional health.
- Pray safety is an issue that brings people together in one accord across political, racial and economic lines and that "guns" not become a point of division.
- Pray protection for children and youth, as well as school personnel.

IMPACT OF TEACHER TURNOVER ON STUDENTS

Pray for a reduction in teacher turnover. Half of teachers nationally leave teaching in the first five years. The Philadelphia Education Research Consortium reported in 9/18 that the problem is especially acute in Philadelphia, where over seven years, an average of 27% of teachers left yearly, some transferring to other schools, and about 15% left the system entirely. Teacher mobility has a negative effect on student achievement, causes lack of consistency and other inequities as inexperienced teachers are concentrated at lower-achieving. As a result, already stressed students have additional challenges to cope with.

- Pray the turnover rate is reduced as teacher training and school climate improve.
- Pray teachers and students each honor and respect the other.
- Pray all teachers experience a supernatural encounter with Jesus that transforms their lives and inspires love for and service to students, parents and community.
- Pray believing educators and students bless staff and students by their Holy Spirit inspired words and actions.

FAMILY MOUNTAIN

Redemptive Purpose:

To demonstrate the unconditional love of God

Primary Stronghold:

Rejection (real or perceived)

PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

Pray that greater parental involvement would aid in breaking cycles of poverty. Research shows children with involved parents earn higher grades and test scores, have better social skills and behavior, as well as greater success in life. Thus one strategy for breaking the cycle of poverty is to provide extensive services to train and support parents. According to PEW Charitable Trust, 37% of Philadelphia's young people under the age of 17 live in poverty, almost 61,000 of these in homes with an annual income of \$12,000 or less for a household of four.

- Pray parents hearts are turned to their children to break the cycles of poverty.
- Pray for deliverance for addicted parents so their relationships with their children can be restored.
- Pray the Church equips parents to raise spiritual champions who walk in Kingdom destiny.

Scriptures: Proverbs 22:6, Deuteronomy 6:6-9, Hebrews 12:7-11, Proverbs 3:1-12, Proverbs 13:24

PROTECTING CHILDREN AND YOUTH FROM HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND SEXUAL PREDATORS

Pray adults and children learn to spot potential predators and know what to do about them. In recent years there have been numerous reports of attempted children/teen snatchings in the Philadelphia region. Most times, the perpetrators were sexual predators or human traffickers. As recently as 9/18, 20 child predators were arrested in NJ (CBS Philly) and Philadelphia police are currently looking for over 50 known predators (Roxborough Patch).

- Pray adults/parents awaken to this threat and begin to educate children/youth about it.
- Pray all predators are exposed and that the the angels of the Lord protect at risk children and youth.
- Pray family relationships are so strong that children feel no need to turn to predators for affirmation and feel comfortable reporting dangerous situations that arise.

PORNOGRAPHY

Pray for a revelation of how dangerous porn is and for families to be delivered from its influence. Research has found porn literally rewires the brain, becomes a compulsion, destroys relationships, changes sexual interests, isolates people, warps Godly views of sex and marriage, and connects with violence and sex trafficking. (<https://fightthenewdrug.org/3-reasons-why-watching-porn-is-harmful/>) Further research shows that 79% of porn exposure happens at home, 11 is the average age a child is first exposed to porn, 94% of kids will see porn by age 14, 73% of women and 98% of men reported internet porn use in the last 6 months. (<https://www.roadtoGrace.net/current-porn-statistics/>)

- Pray parents and guardians awaken to the danger of porn, how likely it is their children will encounter it and commit to protecting them from its influence.
- Pray adults deal with the strongholds of lust and addiction in their own lives through prayer, repentance, deliverance, accountability and counseling.
- Pray God's restoration for marriages that have been negatively impacted by porn and the children and youth who have been exposed to it.

GOVERNMENT

MOUNTAIN

Redemptive Purpose:

To rule and legislate with righteousness and justice

Primary Stronghold:

Anti-Christ spirit, pride, corruption

LEGISLATIVE AGENDA

Pray Philadelphia and Pennsylvania represent modern-day abolition through the legislation they pass. As Philadelphia is considered one of the hubs of human trafficking nation wide, we need to tackle this evil on all fronts. City Councilman Greenlee is introducing legislation to prevent traffickers from using massage parlors as a front for human trafficking. State Senators Greenleaf (Bucks) and Leach (Montgomery & Delaware) previously introduced a Safe Harbor Bill that would protect the child victims of human trafficking from being prosecuted for crimes they were forced to commit. Though 34 states have passed this bill, it was taken off the table by committee in Harrisburg, so it needs to be re-introduced.

- Pray God will raise up righteous state/local leaders who will support His legislative agenda, and remove those who won't.
- Pray that any corruption or sin that causes legislators to vote against these bills is revealed, repented of and dealt with.
- Pray City Council, recalling that the first protests against slavery were in Philadelphia, becomes inspired to declare the city a "trafficking free zone" and passes legislation to help make that vision a reality, thus becoming an example to the nation.

MIDTERM ELECTIONS

Continue to pray that God's candidates are chosen in elections free of contention and voter fraud and for post-election peace. Some have declared this midterm election will be the most important in our nation's history, with one pundit even calling Pennsylvania "ground zero". We need to pray God's purposes come to pass.

- Pray revelation of accurate and non-partisan information that will enable voters to align with God's truth.
- Pray for a huge turnout of discerning voters who are committed to righteousness and justice.
- Pray for physical protection for all candidates and their families as well as the nation during and after the campaign season.
- Pray the Lord removes those who might try to unjustly change the results of the election or incite violence.
- Pray for smooth post-election transitions and an increased commitment across party lines for civility and cooperation.



REDUCTION IN POVERTY

Pray for leaders in city government who have a vision and commitment for reducing poverty. As the national poverty rate has dipped, to about 13.4 percent, Philadelphia's has hovered around 26 percent, the highest rate among the 10 largest U.S. cities. That rate has stayed the same for several years, despite the fact that the city's anti-poverty office has spent \$65 million over the last five years and other agencies have been tasked with job creation and job training.

- Pray for efficiency reviews of the anti-poverty office and other offices that are reported to spend a large portion of their budget on staff salaries, lack vision, authority, and sound leadership.
- Pray that new leaders will emerge within city government that are genuinely committed to solving this issue, who provide vision, network agencies, develop comprehensive strategies and delegate authority to assure follow-up.
- Pray for increased commitment from city government in the form of funding (Currently the city provides only \$500,000 of the \$14,000,000 annual budget for anti-poverty office.) and coordinated efforts with grassroots NGOs that are more "boots on the ground" than city government representatives.

MEDIA MOUNTAIN

Redemptive Purpose:

To share the good news of the gospel and the Kingdom of God through uncensored, unbiased truth

Primary Stronghold:

Fear, terror, and manipulation of truth

HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Pray media throughout the region and the state will recognize their responsibility and role in addressing this issue. “The mass media are key drivers for the spread of information, or misinformation about human trafficking. What we know or do not know determines our response to it, what is reported and how it is reported, goes some way in shaping the policy and State action agenda, and has implications for the traffickers and the trafficked” (Dr. Sarah Macharia, World Association of Christian Communication).

- Pray Philadelphia media will take on this issue as one all people can support regardless of affiliation.
- Pray that news outlets will not prioritize sensationalism over fact based reporting.
- Pray the media expose the roles that they themselves, society, consumers and governments play in perpetuating it.
- Pray media investigate the range of local conditions that contribute to making Philadelphia a trafficking hub.

TRANSFORMATION TALKS - “TED TALKS” FOR CHRISTIANS

Pray for a new platform for preparing the people of God to impact the culture. Philadelphia is known for many “firsts” in media. Becoming the home of the first “TED Talks for Christians” could be another. “Transformation Talks” could be one expression of Kingdom Journalism that shares information and inspiring ideas that enable Christians to better engage and influence the culture.

- Pray for God to raise up visionary Christian journalists who commit to creating a new platform for informing and preparing the ecclesia to take their place as leaders in all arenas of the culture.
- Pray those in Christian media throughout the region unite around this new platform for the sake of the Kingdom.
- Pray for funding to support Transformation Talks.
- Pray for all of God’s strategies come forth for Christians to invade the marketplace and influence the culture.



CYBER PREDATORS

Pray for greater awareness of the problem and commitment to finding solutions. The Combat Online Predator Act, that passed in the House (April 2018) and has now gone to the U. S. Senate, “was spurred by the frightening ordeal of a Bucks County family” whose daughter was cyber-bullied by the father of a friend. That’s one of numerous stories of the internet being used by sexual predators or teen bullies in the Delaware Valley. There are an estimated 500,000 sexual predators on line daily.

- Pray parents have greater discernment in allowing children and teens access to technology and social media.
- Pray schools and media companies offer on-going education for parents and children/youth about how predators operate and what to do about them.
- Pray for laws that enable law enforcement to pursue suspected predators more aggressively and judges to hand down sentences that would be a deterrent to future bad acts.
- Pray any victims of cyber predators are healed from trauma and predators repent, are saved, and delivered.

RELIGION MOUNTAIN

Redemptive Purpose:

Equipping the saints for the work of ministry

Primary Stronghold:

Idolatry that steals worship from God

THE CRISIS IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH OF PHILADELPHIA

Pray exposure, justice, repentance and healing regarding sexual abuse in Pennsylvania's Catholic Church. This summer, PA Attorney General Josh Shapiro released a grand-jury report revealing 99 "predator priests" in the Pittsburgh area alone. More than 300 priests statewide were identified, and over 1,000 victims offered detailed accounts of abuse. A grand jury believed the actual number of abused children was in the "thousands." The two-year investigation was the nation's most comprehensive report on child sexual abuse within the Catholic Church and followed the exposure, arrests and convictions in Philadelphia over the last 15+ years.

- Pray the Church would follow Holy Spirit's leading to solutions rather than white-washing the moral failings in the church.
- Pray that victory in the Church over sexual sin and abuse would give us greater authority to deal with it in our culture.
- Pray for total healing and closure for the victims of these now exposed sins, and for those whose faith has been shaken.
- Pray for the offending priests that they too would be healed and restored to fellowship with God.
- Pray that sexual sin in all denominations and churches is exposed and dealt with.

ALPHA CARE

Pray the favor of God for Alpha Care. Alpha Care is a 24/7 crisis pregnancy clinic literally next door to the infamous clinic run by the abortion doctor, Kermit Gosnell who is now serving life in prison for his crimes. They offer assistance to women who are facing and unexpected pregnancies. Registered nurses are on staff to give free pregnancy testing and free ultrasounds. Assistance with making arrangements for healthcare is also offered, however, they DO NOT refer for abortions.

- Pray for abundant funding and volunteer resources for this lifesaving organization.
- Pray every obstacle be removed so that AlphaCare can purchase 3801 Lancaster Ave., the former site Gosnell's business.
- Pray for the staff's wisdom and sensitivity in every case, especially women who come to them with tremendous fear.
- Declare that they are the expression of God's perfect love that casts out all fear.
- Pray for a trauma healing course that AlphaCare staff will be teaching (November 5-7) for workers at other pregnancy centers on how to counsel those with unexpected pregnancies or who have already had an abortion.

THE CRISIS OF GENTRIFICATION OF MINORITY CHURCHES

Pray revelation from God on how to deal with the impact of changing demographics on churches. The changing uses of church buildings are markers for migration patterns. In neighborhoods that are rapidly changing, churches that have once served the community with critical ministries to the poor, homeless, youth, seniors, etc. are left vulnerable.

- Pray for the churches which are now struggling financially because they have seen their congregation size shrink by as much as 80% due to gentrification in certain neighborhoods in Philadelphia.
- Pray that churches would get Godly inspiration on reaching a more diverse audience without compromising the Gospel.
- Pray for a desegregated church in Philadelphia.
- Pray all those forced out of their neighborhoods remain faithful to God and remain connected to their home church.

Scriptures: John 17:21-22; Ephesians 4:4; 1 Corinthians 12:20, 25-27, Hebrews 10: 24-25



GENERAL PROPHETIC

The following are prophetic perceptions gleaned from a time of prayer and sharing of several respected leaders in the Greater Philadelphia region. The points below are areas where many were sensing the same thing from the Lord.

PHILADELPHIA - A GOVERNMENTAL CITY

Pray for Philadelphia's destiny as a governmental city. Philadelphia has always had a calling to be a governmental city. Although the national capital was moved from here, the Lord desires the Church of Philadelphia to be a governmental people, representing His Kingdom of righteousness, justice and love (please note, kingdom government is different from political). The main building block of government is self-government manifested in personal righteousness and holiness, and the next building block is well-governed families. With these in place the church can then thrive in its governmental calling (Genesis 18:19).

- Pray for a revelation of the 'ekklesia'. The Church is called to be a legislative governing body in addition to being a family and household of faith (Matthew 16:18-19)
- Declare that the Father is restoring His original design and that the Church is embodying that destiny (Romans 8: 19).
- Pray for deep repentance among believers where we have not governed ourselves or our families well. Declare that the Holy Spirit is empowering us to govern ourselves and families as we are intended to (Joshua 24:15).

Scriptures: Isaiah 9:6-7, Ephesians 1:22-23, 1 Peter 2:9, 1 Timothy 3:4-5, 1 Corinthians 10:13, Proverbs 25:28

WALKING ACCORDING TO THE PATH OF GOD

Pray for the way of the Lord to be plain for all to see. Many have sensed that this is a season of great spiritual warfare. However, as always, the Lord has a way that leads to life and victory. In the midst of the battlefield there is an opening, a pathway that the Lord leads us on - it is the ancient path of His word and truth (Jeremiah 6:16).

- Pray that the Body of Christ would awaken to see the opening set before us. Like Jacob, pray that we would awake to see that the Lord is in the place where we are and has opened a gateway for us (Genesis 28:10-17).
- Declare that God is making a way and that He is still the One who parted the seas and swallowed up all the enemies of His people. Declare that the Church of Philadelphia will not miss the day of deliverance and visitation (Exodus 14:13-31).
- Pray that the Church in the Delaware Valley would receive the protective care of the Lord that comes with making Him our hiding place. Declare that all other places of refuge are being removed so that we will fully rely on the Lord (Psalm 91).

Scriptures: Jeremiah 18:15, Isaiah 43:16-19, Isaiah 30:19-22, Ephesians 6:12-18, John 16:33, 1 Corinthians 10:13,

THE CHURCH OF PHILADELPHIA ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN DETERMINING THE FUTURE INSTEAD OF REACTING TO IT

Pray that the Church of Philadelphia (which includes the entire Delaware Valley) would move from 'defense' mode to 'crisis' mode. Several people have perceived that the Lord is saying we need to be in 'crisis mode'. The following definition of 'crisis' is extremely relevant: a stage in a sequence of events at which the trend of all future events, especially for better or for worse, is determined; turning point. In Greek, the word 'krisis' means decision or judgment (Isaiah 28:5-6).

- Pray for every bloodline in the Greater Philadelphia area to turn to the Lord so they can be blessed and have abundant life in the days ahead. Call each one out of darkness and into the light. Declare a new course (2 Corinthians 3:16).
- Declare that Philadelphia has come to her new day and that this new day is to the glory of the Lord. Pray for protection against the aborting of Father's purposes (Psalm 118:24).
- Declare the righteous judgments of the Lord against the enemies (not flesh and blood) of Philadelphia. Declare the victory of the cross and the judgment that was rendered through Christ's death and resurrection (Colossians 2:15).
